# **General Louis Wagner Middle School Parent and Family Engagement Policy**

# **Section A: JOINTLY DEVELOPED**

<u>Wagner Middle School</u> will take the following actions to involve parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely manner in the planning, review, and improvement of Title I programs, including opportunities for regular meetings, if requested by parents, to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their child and respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicably possible. The school will:

- Parents are invited to the Annual Spring Title I Meeting, during which time parent documents are reviewed and updated. This year, that meeting was held on May 11, 2022 and this document was developed.
- Throughout the 2020-21 school year, parents will be invited to share their input/feedback during monthly SAC meetings and via parent survey.

# **Section B: ANNUAL TITLE I MEETING**

- In September 2020, parents will be invited to attend the Annual Title I Meeting via the school calendar, school website, flyer, and school messenger (robo call). - Present information to parents and families at our annual Back to School Night, School Advisory Council meetings and other meetings related to Title I (Fall, Spring, and Winter Title I Parental Input meetings).

<u>Wagner Middle School</u> will coordinate and host workshops and events that will empower parents and families to support school-home learning connections. Topics are informed by parent feedback and include topics such as: Progress Monitoring via the Parent Portal, Literacy and Math workshops, High School Selection Process, Preparing for High School, Preparing for the PSSA. During the Annual Title I meeting the Principal or her designee will discuss the state's academic standards and assessments, information about the Title I requirements, and how to monitor their child's progress. Parents will also be provided with information on how to effectively work with teachers and staff and the school curriculum.

# Section H: BUILDING CAPACITY OF SCHOOL STAFF

<u>Wagner Middle School</u> will provide training to educate teachers, specialized instructional support personnel, principals, and other school leaders, and other staff, with the assistance of parents, in the value and utility of contributions of parents, and in how to reach out to, communicate with, and work with parents as equal partners, implement and coordinate parent programs, and build ties between parents and the school by:

 During a scheduled professional development day in the Fall, the Principal will provide training to staff about providing positive communication with parents and building effective partnerships.
